- Far Right (continued):** "Column following up on one that ordered Joe Biden to quit, ordering Democrats, 'They need to tell [Biden] that his defiance threatens to hand victory to Mr. Trump'" points to the column "The Democrats Party War? Biden's Plan to Stay".
